Choose one book that you have not previously read from each category.

For each book, prepare a **typed report**, at least two (2) pages in length (use ACCA Style Sheet) including the basics (**title, author, date of publication, plot, main characters, main theme(s), notable quotes, your reflection on the book**) to be handed in the first day of the 2010-2011 school year in Omnibus class. Your teacher may ask you questions about your readings and/or you may have an opportunity to present your report(s) to the class.

I. Historical fiction

Quo Vadis by Henry Sienkiewicz

The Robe by Lloyd C. Douglas

Ben Hur by Lew Wallace

II. Mystery

Death on the Nile by Agatha Christie

Murder in Mesopotamia by Agatha Christie

Murder on the Orient Express by Agatha Christie

III. Miscellaneous

Space Trilogy by Clive Staples Lewis (series of 3 books: *Out of the Silent Planet*, *Perelandra*, *That Hideous Strength*)

The Grapes of Wrath by John Steinbeck

Or a book of your choice (that you have not previously read): You may choose from any category of books: fiction, nonfiction, biography, etc. **This book should not be chosen from the children or juvenile section of the library.** Each book should be at least 200 pages and be one that you have not read previously. Attached is the College Board 101 Books to Read Before Going to College list. This may be helpful in making your choice.
